
PROJECT BASED LEARNING

We appreciate whānau understanding our need to have a Teacher Only Day, to visit a school that is delivering a successful Project Based Learning Programme. We are looking forward to using what we observed in Hamilton in the delivery of our own programmes.

In Term 4 we will be trialling grouping our tamariki according to their Multiple Intelligence which we believe are whakapapa traits or Whakapapa Greatness eg/ Kinesthetic (Hands On), Intrapersonal (individual), Visual – Spatial (Artistic)... There are 8 Multiple Intelligences all together. The structure we will use with Multiple Intelligences is Blooms Taxonomy which is a Higher Level Thinking Structure being (remembering, knowing, understanding, creating, evaluating, analysing). We will be aligning the Multiple Intelligences to our Marau ā Kura which is based around our maunga framework and includes the awa of Waikare.

Multiple Intelligences, Blooms Taxonomy and AKO will be our Pedagogical Practices. We will be collecting your child's 3 most strongest intelligence which will also be a start to creating an electronic student profile. We are all excited to trial this to fully implement next year.
